Huddle: Low-cost workspaces

Huddle is an online collaboration workspace that's great for project management when you have several people working on a project. Set deadlines, assign tasks and more. Free for nonprofits, low-cost for others. Other choices: Basecamp and Trello.



Tor

Tor is free software and an open network that helps you defend against network surveillance, enhancing personal freedom and privacy and protecting confidential activities.



Collaborative scheduling

Need to figure out when everyone is free for a call or meeting? **When is Good** (\$10/yr.) is an easy way to schedule meetings, including times that work best! Other choices: **Doodle,Tungle.me**



Access & transfer files

Want to access your docs from anywhere? Need to transfer video files? **Dropbox** lets you store up to 2MB of files for free, with different price levels for teams. And don't forget **Evernote** to access notes from anywhere.



Project management with mobile

DeskAway is a Web-based project collaboration software that gives teams a central location to easily organize, manage, share and track your projects. With its mobile component, you'll know that your work is going on smoothly when you're in the field or away from your desk.



Collaborate on documents

If you're not using **Google Docs** (free) for working on Word docs or spreadsheets across different departments or groups, you're missing out on one of the coolest platforms in the cloud.



Brainstorming made easier

Mindmeister is a cool online mind mapping and collaboration tool that will help with your group projects and presentations. The basic version, for three mind maps, is free.



Free voice & audio chat

Get together for online meetings, by audio or video, using **Skype**. You can share files and even make international calls, all for free. Record Skype calls with Call Recorder.



Connect across chat applications

Connect instantly with staff, volunteers and the rest of your community regardless of which instant messaging application they use with either **Pidgin** (for PCs) or **Adium** (for Macs). Both are free, open source downloadable applications that allow you to connect with almost anyone running AIM, MSN, Jabber, Yahoo, Google Talk, MSN, IRC, Facebook and other chat networks.
